There will only be an "A" Ride

Meet at 8:45 am at Tim's on First St for a 9:00 departure.

- We will head east out of town via Georgian Trail and the Rail Trail to 6th line. We then head south on 6th to Airport Road. Then east again to the traffic circle at Beechwood and Mosley. Turning south on Lyons Drive and east again on to the wooded and winding Carly Pattison Trail into Wasaga. Then across Mosley at the 39th St. traffic light and work over to the bridge using McCague. Immediately after crossing the bridge, we turn right onto Oxbow Park then take the first two lefts leaving us on Woodland Drive. At the end of Woodland Drive is the very large sand dune along a bend of the river.
- We return along the same route as inbound until we again cross the Nottawasaga Bridge where we turn right onto 28th Street and into the park. Using provincial park trails, Shore Lane and Beechwood we head back to Collingwood for lunch at Montana's at approx. 12:30.

The ride is about 46 km. very flat.

Tires with more than 25mm width will be happier
