This will be a relaxing ride.

The focus will be on nature and the area trail systems.

The ride will be mostly on trails or on quiet roads except for about 3 kms on Airport Road on the way to the Wasaga Dunes and about 2½ kms on Beachwood Road on our return. The trails are in good condition, but 23-25mm tires will not be very happy in a couple of soft spots. You might want to bring your other bike Al.

We start by heading east to the Train station/Museum and take the train trail all the way to Airport Road. Then east across Hwy 26 to the roundabout at the end of Mosely and south on Lyons Court to the beginning of the Carly Patterson trail. This trail will lead us away from housing and busy roads through wooded areas to 39th Street in Wasaga. From there, after some zigging and zagging on quiet streets to get ourselves across the Nottawasaga River on Mosely, comes a rest stop to enjoy the splendor of the sand dunes.

Full of awe and wonder, we head back to Collingwood using the provincial park and shore line roads and trails, except for the aforementioned stretch along Beachwood.
